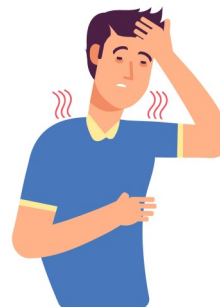

This practice is one of over 1900 practices in England contributing pseudonymised data for national surveillance and research. These data enable continuous monitoring of infections and diseases in the community and is used in ethically approved research. The pseudonymised data, extracted by an information service provider, Magentus, is processed with the private and secure network of the Oxford-Royal College of General Practitioners Clinical Informatics Digital Hub (ORCHID) at the University of Oxford under a formal data sharing agreement. The pseudonymised data may be linked with other NHS data for analysis, including data from point of care machines.

Providing pseudonymised data does not affect patients, their care or privacy, however if you no longer wish to allow your information to be used, please speak to your GP.
