

Accessing the on line R and RStudio Workbook

This Workbook is designed to provide an introduction to R and RStudio. It is divided into modules each of which can be worked through in a short period of time. People without any prior knowledge should be able to work through these modules in their own time first of all to develop a basic understanding of R and RStudio and then to learn how to undertake the basic procedures that will typically be needed in order to process pseudonymised clinical data. Over time further modules will be added to cover more advanced data processing and statistical analysis.

The modules are grouped in a single folder along with an index which gives a brief description of each module and its intended learning outcomes. From that index file it is possible to hyperlink out to each of the modules. They are all pdf files.

The Index file is called: **00Index to R and RStudio Workbook.pdf**

It is recommended that you start by opening this file to get an overview of the modules available. The modules are designed to be studied in sequence.

To access and download the Workbook folder:

Either click on the URL below or copy and paste it into your web browser

Click on the green tab labelled: Clone or download

Select the option: Download ZIP

If you get a dialogue box with a choice, select “open with Windows Explorer”
If the file simply immediately downloads then find it in your downloads folder, right click it and select: Open

This should open the ZIP file and reveal the folder: **Workbook-master**

Right click on this and copy.

Paste the folder into a convenient place of your own choosing. Note that it is important to carry out this copy and paste routine and not simply attempt to access the folder as downloaded

You should now be able to open this folder to find the index file and all of the modules
